Reflection for this Sunday: On the 4th Sunday of Easter Year C, also known as Good Shepherd Sunday, we are invited to reflect deeply on Jesus as our caring and guiding Shepherd. This special Sunday highlights the powerful imagery of Jesus calling each of us by name, leading us with love, and inviting all people into His flock.
