**Reflection for this Sunday:** Corpus Christi celebrates the profound gift of the Eucharist, the central mystery of our faith, where Jesus Christ, our eternal High Priest, offers himself to the Father for our salvation and unites us with God and with one another. The readings remind us of the eternal priesthood foreshadowed by Melchizedek’s offering of bread and wine, and fulfilled in Jesus, who continues to make himself present to us in every Mass. The Gospel of the miraculous feeding of the crowd reflects God’s abundant and generous love, revealing how even our smallest offerings, when placed in Jesus’ hands, can become a source of great blessing. The Eucharist is also the sign of the new covenant—God’s enduring promise of love and faithfulness—renewed each time we receive the Body and Blood of Christ. As we celebrate this solemn feast, we are called to respond with deep faith, gratitude, and love, recognizing that Jesus nourishes our souls and strengthens us to live in service to others. Let us open our hearts to this sacred mystery and joyfully share Christ’s love with the world.
