

SAINTS PETER & PAUL, APOSTLES

Entrance Antiphon: “These are the ones who, living in the flesh, planted the Church with their blood; they drank the chalice of the Lord and became the friends of God”

Communion Antiphon: “Peter said to Jesus: You are the Christ, the Son of the living God. And Jesus replied: You are Peter, and upon this rock I will build my Church.” Cf. Mt 16: 16,18

Reflection for this Sunday: On June 29, the Church honors Saints Peter and Paul, two foundational pillars of our faith whose lives and witness shaped the early Christian Church. Though their journeys to Christ were vastly different—Peter, a humble fisherman called by Jesus to lead His apostles, and Paul, a former persecutor of Christians radically converted on the road to Damascus—they became united in mission and martyrdom. Peter was entrusted by Jesus to be the “rock” upon which the Church would be built, serving as its first Pope and guiding the early Christian community with strength and compassion, despite his human failings. Paul, once known as Saul, encountered the risen Lord in a dramatic vision that transformed him into Christianity’s greatest missionary to the Gentiles. Through tireless travels and inspired letters, Paul helped define key teachings on faith, grace, and salvation. Both apostles gave their lives for the Gospel in Rome—Peter crucified upside down and Paul beheaded—offering the ultimate witness of faith and courage. Their feast day not only commemorates their heroic sacrifices but also reminds us of the Church’s unity, rooted in Peter’s leadership and Paul’s evangelizing spirit. Together, they teach us that God can work through anyone—fisherman or Pharisee, bold preacher or penitent sinner—to carry out His divine plan. As we reflect on their lives, let us be inspired to trust God more deeply, to seek forgiveness when we fall, to embrace our own call to discipleship, and to share the Gospel with courage and joy. Saints Peter and Paul, pray for us!
