#### **Second Sunday of Advent**

**Entrance Antiphon:** "O people of Sion, behold, the Lord will come to save the nations, and the Lord will make the glory of his voice heard in the joy of your heart." Cf. Is 30: 19, 30

**Communion Antiphon:** Jerusalem, arise and stand upon the heights, and behold the joy which comes to you from God. Bar 5: 5; 4: 36

Reflection for this Sunday: The 2nd Sunday of Advent calls us to prepare for the coming of Christ through justice, repentance, and hope, as beautifully presented in the readings from Isaiah, Romans, and the Gospel of Matthew. Isaiah offers a powerful vision of a leader from the line of Jesse who will rule with wisdom, fairness, and peace, bringing harmony not only among people but even within creation itself—an image that inspires us to work for justice and peace in our own communities and relationships today. John the Baptist's bold call to repentance in the Gospel challenges us to go beyond words and religious labels, urging a true change of heart that bears fruit in how we live, serve, and love others. He reminds us that faith is proven not by ancestry or status, but by how sincerely we live God's will. Together, Isaiah and John point us toward Jesus as the true and perfect leader—one who leads not with power, but with mercy, truth, humility, and self-giving love. This Sunday invites us to examine who leads us, how we lead others, and whether our lives reflect the peace and justice of God's Kingdom. As we continue our Advent journey, we are encouraged to prepare our hearts more deeply for Christ by living justly, repenting sincerely, choosing what is good, and allowing God's hope to shape our daily lives.
