WHAT IS THE MEANING OF A SANCTARY LAMP?

A Sanctuary Candle is a wax candle, generally in a red glass container, kept burning day and night wherever the Blessed Sacrament is reserved in Catholic Churches or Chapels, signifying His presence in the Tabernacle. It is an emblem of Christ's abiding love and a reminder to the faithful to respond with loving adoration in Return.

The Sanctuary Candle is often kept burning for 7 days in memory of a loved one, to honor a special occasion, or a special intention.
